

**RESOLUTION NO. 035**

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
OF THE CRESTLINE SANITATION DISTRICT  
REVOKING THE ADOPTION OF THE  
ALL-MAILED BALLOT PROCEDURE FOR  
CONDUCTING GENERAL DISTRICT ELECTIONS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Crestline Sanitation District finds as follows:

A. The Crestline Sanitation District (“the District”) is a sanitation district organized and operating pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 4700 et seq.

B. On April 13, 2010, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino adopted Resolution No. 2010-58 which established certain criteria for the election of directors to serve as members of the Board of Directors of the District upon formation of the District as an independent self-governed public agency.

C. Section 15 of said Resolution No. 2010-58 provides that all elections for the District’s Board of Directors held after the November 2015 Consolidated General Election “shall be conducted by mail in August of odd numbered years for four years terms.”

D. Pursuant to Elections Code Section 4003, the District’s Board of Directors may, by resolution, revoke the adoption of the all-mailed ballot procedure and return to the procedure otherwise prescribed by law for conducting general District elections at polling places, and not by all-mailed ballots, on such authorized dates as are set forth in the Elections Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the District’s Board of Directors does hereby rescind and revoke the provisions of Section 15 of Resolution No. 2010-58 which require the August odd-year all-mailed ballot procedure for conducting regular District elections held after the November 2015 general election, and hereby expresses its desire to remain in the November odd-year consolidated general election cycle.



Dear Mr. Pattison,

According to Elections Office records, the Crestline Sanitation District Resolution No. 2010-58 establishes that after the November 2015 Consolidated General Election the district's elections will move to the August odd-year mail ballot election cycle following.

As of today, fourteen districts participating in the August odd-year election have moved to the November odd-year election. Two of the remaining three districts in the August election cycle have taken action to move to the November odd-year election.

As a result of these election changes from August to November, Crestline Sanitation District may experience an increase in election costs if the district moves to the August election. By contrast, if the District remains in the November election, the Elections Office estimates a cost savings of 10-20% for participating jurisdictions.

If your district would like to remain in the November election cycle, California Elections Code § 4003 enables the district to make this move by a resolution of the governing board. While we believe the district's ability and method to change election dates is accurate, please be sure to seek advice from your legal counsel prior to any action by your governing board.
